AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STREET PARKING IN A RESIDENTIAL AREA


The City Council for the City of Madison Lake met this 5th day of August, 2019, and with resident and business input, discussed parking challenges along the 500 Block of Lakeshore Drive.

The City Council discussed the increased traffic and higher demand for parking locations in this area and noted that the City is receiving complaints from residents regarding parking in this particular area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MADISON LAKE, MINNESOTA:

1. Effective immediately, any and all parking shall be prohibited for the entire length of the north/east side (residential side) of the 500 Block of Lakeshore Drive. Parking shall be prohibited on the south/east side (lake side) of the 500 Block of Lakeshore Drive starting 35 feet back from the northeastern most property line of parcel identification number R140534452018 and then continuing east for the rest of the 500 Block of Lakeshore Drive. Prohibited areas shall be signed accordingly.
2. Any violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a petty misdemeanor and subject to a fine of \$25.


