### Items for Collection

**Regular Refuse**..... **No Charge**  
Couches (without hide-a-bed), carpet, chairs, tables, dried out paint cans, grills without propane/gas tank, windows, fiberglass tub, etc. All items should be boxed, bagged, or contained in some manner.

**Appliances**..... **\$35.00 Each**  
Clothes washers and dryers, hot water heaters, water softeners, humidifiers, dishwashers, heat pumps, furnaces, garbage disposals, trash compactors, conventional and microwave ovens, ranges and stoves, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators and freezers. NOTE: Please remove doors from freezers and refrigerators.

**Electronics**..... **\$25.00 Each**  
Personal computers, monitors, portable TV, console TV, large screen TV, desktop printer, desktop fax, desktop copier, console Hi-Fi, stereo. **Large electronics/consoles \$50.00 each**

**Tires**..... **See Below**  
Cars.....\$12.00 each (on rim \$15.00 each)  
Light Truck.....\$14.00 each (on rim \$17.00 each)  
Tractor .....\$30.00 each (on rim \$40.00 each)

**Vehicle Batteries**..... **\$15.00 Each**

### Unacceptable Waste

Unacceptable waste includes such waste that would likely pose a threat to health, safety, and/or the environment. Unacceptable waste may include hazardous waste of any kind or nature such as explosives, radioactive materials, cleaning fluids, crankcase oils, paints, acids, caustics, poisons, pesticides or drugs, pathological or biological waste, sanitary sewage and other highly diluted water carried material substances, human or animal waste, sludge, including sewage sludge and septic and cesspool pump outs; human and animal remains, solvents, liquid waste, street sweepings, mining waste, incinerator residue, transformers, batteries (except for vehicle batteries as listed above), aerosol cans, trees, demolition debris, ashes, foundry sand, concrete rubble, rock, gravel, construction debris, grass clippings, shrubs, plants, tree limbs, leaves, motor oil, motor filters, fluorescent lights, incandescent light bulbs, cement, or asphalt. Mattresses, box springs and hide-a-beds are also unacceptable.
